

Seastream's 650 well underway - with new management team

The first hull has been produced in the new 25m oven at Seastream's Falmouth shipyard.

Speaking at the time, Seastream's newly appointed joint Managing Director, Nigel Woodcock said: "My background in composites and working closely with SP Systems and Dubois Naval Architects, coupled with the new highly efficient building facility means we can build lightweight, strong cruising yachts up to 80ft with a high performance pedigree".

The new 650 hull was post cured at 50 degrees centigrade for 16 hours.
