






Saloon portside - Navigation table with carefully grouped, splayed and angled instruments and screens. Main A/C D/C panel with cover removed. Note also the forecabin watertight bulkhead and door.



The cockpit is very large yet totally safe and of course self draining. Pushpit viewing seats keep everyone happy when sailing. Just visible is the fold out transom boarding/bathing platform.

The enormous bridge deck with its centreline handrail is well protected by the fixed screen and sprayhood (not shown).





Saloon - looking aft into the Owner's cabin with large double bed layout. This cabin also has a private toilet and separate shower stall. The saloon table in the photo is contracted to "walk around" size.



Main foredeck with beautifully laid swept teak decks - quite large enough to carry the tender inflated. Hatches over all compartments give full light air and deck access.
